## New Business:

• Motion approved - The Nominating Committee (Jackie Szalanski, Jen Shea, Katie Frick) moves forward two excellent candidates for the position of President-Elect 2024-2025. The



candidates will be voted on during the last PTA meeting of the year on May 15, 2024 by simple written ballot. All eligible PTA members present may participate in the vote. Votes will be tallied and the winner announced at the meeting. The two candidates have submitted biographical information to provide the PTA at large more details about what they have accomplished and what special skills they bring to the table.

- Candidate 1: Sydney Musselman Sydney is the mom to 4th grader, Luke. She is a graphic designer, a hiker, an artist, and an enthusiast of anything she takes on, and someone who never stops learning. She has been involved in the Downers Grove community as chair of the Downers Grove Historic Society's Historic Home Committee, and served as a two-year member of the Superintendent's Advisory Council, and is currently the only non-faculty member on District 58's Community Communications Committee. She is also the New Member Coordinator for Cub Scout Pack 3086, and has doubled the size of the pack during her tenure. Within the Lester community, she chairs the Teacher Support Committee and co-chairs the Book Fair Committee. Through all of these experiences, she has developed a wide set of leadership skills. She takes the time to form relationships with the people she works with, is not afraid to ask for help or learn what she needs to get the job done, and is comfortable with delegating tasks to make sure all of the work gets done efficiently. She champions "inclusion," and she calls herself a "data driven creative." She loves coming up with new ideas to solve problems and is very organized. If elected, she looks forward to the opportunity to help support and improve collaborations between parents and teachers at Lester.
- Candidate 2: Julia Mazurek Julia is the mom to two current Leopards, Nicholas, a 6th 0 grader, and Theo, 1st grader, and one former Leopard, Luke, an 8th grader. She has nearly 9 years of being a Lester parent and another 4 to go, offering a unique perspective. Julia started off her volunteership with Lester with the Lester Community Playground Committee in 2019. As that wrapped up, the pandemic hit. What started as an inquiry to the PTA on the challenging year ahead, eventually led to a PTA board position the following year. As VP of Communications, Julia introduced a PTA survey to generate parent and teacher feedback; the results led to actionable recommendations on what the PTA does and how it does it. She also overhauled the PTA weekly eBlast newsletter and the PTA website to improve the communication to Lester parents. As the current VP of Fundraising, in collaboration with 3 other dynamo Lester moms, she helped to overhaul the sponsorship program. This was a huge undertaking which resulted in more impact for Lester's generous sponsors, a more efficient and effective effort for the volunteers, and most importantly, more funds to invest in programs for Lester students. Her "day job" of VP of Fundraising is co-chairing the Fun Run alongside Katie Frick. Together they introduced many new elements at this year's race, continually seeking ways to improve the event. These experiences set up an opportunity to make a positive impact as PTA President.
- Budget presentation and any questions



- We are presenting our Draft 2024/2025 Budget tonight.
- We have proposed reducing a number of budget lines to bring our spending in line with our anticipated fundraising for next year. Some notable reductions include reducing the PE and Library budgets to be in line with the other Specials, reducing the number of PTA-funded assemblies next year, reducing the overall PTA-funded field trip budget, no purchasing or subsidizing of yearbooks (other than for F&R students), and reducing the number of scholarships we will be offering to Lester alumni. In many cases, we have merely returned funding to our pre-COVID levels now that we have spent the remaining budget surplus from those years.
