New Business:



- New Proposed Budget. Due to projected spending the executive board met and scrubbed every line item to find some budget favorability and we are proposing the attached budget to finish out the 2023-2024 school year.
- Major Changes and highlights:
 - Lowered Anticipated Fun Lunch Expenses. This is a result of updated calculations and does not in any way effect the funding for fun lunch by the PTA for children who need it.
 - Increased costs for the PTA funded portion of the 6th grad yearbook. This is primarily
 due to larger class sizes. This will be evaluated and taken into account for future years.
 - Decrease to family reading night budget due to holding only 1 for this school year.
 - Elimination of One Book One School. Will re-evaluate for future years.
 - Elimination of the teacher grant and supply refresh for the year
 - Elimination of the award winning and reading games book purchases for this year.
 - Lowered assembly and guest speaker costs based upon actual anticipated spending.
 - Lowered budgets for Teacher Appreciation and Teacher Hospitality. The plan would be to solicit help from parents for snacks, etc.
 - Lowered annual scholarship amounts to provide 3 vs. 7 for this year.
 - Lowered cub club/class ambassador due to actual spending
 - Lowered funding for free and reduced snacks due to actual spending trends. Note that funding for fun lunch for these students is included in the fun lunch budget.
 - Lowered office supplies and postage due to actual spending.
